VEDETT BLONDE | 33cl | LAGER 7

*Blond, light, and crisp premium lager  
Barley - 5%*

BRUGSE ZOT BLOND | 33cl | ABBEY 8

*Complex flavours of spice, orange, lemon and a delicate malty sweetness are balanced by a certain bitterness and refreshing dryness  
Barley - 6%*

KARMELIET TRIPEL | 33cl | ABBEY 11

*Bold aromas and flavours of bananas, a subtle wheat spiciness, vanilla, bubblegum, orange, and florals  
Wheat, oats and barley - 8.4%*

CHIMAY BLUE | 33cl | TRAPPIST 11.5

*Rich and intense with lovely caramel notes and dry finish  
Barley and wheat - 9%*

CHIMAY RED | 33cl | TRAPPIST 8.5

*Aromas and flavours of fruity apricot, figs, and cloves are balanced by a nice hoppiness and a refreshing finish  
Barley and wheat - 7%*

CHIMAY CINQ CENT | 75cl | TRAPPIST 25

*Distinct notes of white raisins, green apples and floral. Its taste is mostly reminiscent of caramel, plums spices and a complementary bitterness.  
A long, sweet aftertaste and a full and creamy body  
Wheat, oats and barley - 8%*

ORVAL | 33cl | TRAPPIST 8.5

*Smooth yet crisp, tart yet dry. It carries with it flavours of lemon rind, freshly-cut hay, notes of spice and aromas of flowers and lemon  
Barley - 6.2%*

## BELGIAN BEERS



### WESTMALLE TRIPLE | 33cl | TRAPPIST 12.5

*Delicate aromas of spice and citrus fruits are complemented by initial flavours of spices mingling with the alcohol. These initial notes then morph into peaches, citrus, pepper and coriander, with moderate bitter finish*

*Wheat, oats and barley - 9.5%*

### KWAK | 33cl/75cl | STRONG ALE 11/25

*Starting out slightly bitter it quickly turns sweeter with flavours of caramel and bread and subtle hints of alcohol*

*Barley and wheat - 8.4%*

### LA CHOUFFE | 33cl/75cl | STRONG ALE 12/26

*Golden Amber with sweet malts, orange peel and coriander aromas, caramel taste with a hint of coriander and mild yeast*

*Barley - 8%*

### DUVEL | 33cl | STRONG ALE 11

*Glittering Gold, fruity and flowery aromas. The spicy hints of yeast season the whole along with sharp and strong bitterness*

*Barley - 8.5%*

### BLANCHE DE BRUXELLES | 33cl | WITBIER 7

*Aromas of light malts and hops with a hint of yeast, orange and light coriander, followed by citrus finish*

*Wheat - 4.5%*

### LA CHOUFFE CHERRY | 33cl | FRUIT BEER 12

*Strawberry, almond spices and sweet port notes, rounded body, soft and delicate*

*Barley & Cherry - 8%*

### SAISON DUPONT | 33cl | SAISON 8

*Refreshing in a tart way with fruity aromas and citrus, freshly mown grass and hay*

*Barley - 6.5%*

## CHAMPAGNE



### LAURENT-PERRIER

*Laurent-Perrier was established in 1812. The house remains under the direction of the De Nonancourt family to this day. Laurent-Perrier pioneered the production of Ultra Brut champagne and set the benchmark for Rosé Champagne using the Saignée method. Awarded with the Prince of Wales's Royal Warrant and throughout the range, produces elegant champagnes.*

### BOLLINGER

*The Bollinger vineyard covers 179 hectares, most of which are classified Grand or Premier cru. Pinot Noir predominates, a demanding grape variety with an intense character which forms the backbone of the Bollinger style. Continuity of style is ensured by an exceptional collection of over 800,000 reserve magnums, making Bollinger the only champagne House with such a wide and precise palette of aromas for their blends. As a guarantee of supreme quality, the best crus are vinified in wood thanks to a stock of 4,000 small, aged casks.*

### DOM PÉRIGNON

*Dom Pérignon's reputation needs no introduction: it is arguably one of the most prestigious brands of fine Champagne in the industry. Created and named after Pierre Pérignon, the 17th-century Benedictine monk who worked in the cellars of the Benedictine Abbey of Hautvillers, To this day, Dom Pérignon still enjoys the same respect for its vintage varieties, thanks to its unique experimentation of blending and fine-tuning both white Chardonnay and red Pinot Noir grapes*
